Our mission is to promote the art and artists of the Mid-Columbia and provide a forum for the promotion and development of the arts.

Trout Lake Arts Festival of the Arts is sponsored by the **Trout Lake Arts Council** a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization. For the past twelve years, the Council has organized and presented a two-day art and music festival in the Trout Lake Valley.

The site of the Festival is a historic farm which houses **The Farm, a B&B**, owned and operated by Dean and Rosie Hostetter, hosts extraordinaire. The site invites visitors to wander through its rustic barn where much of the artwork is displayed, shade trees, and a beautiful perennial garden. There is **no admission fee** and plenty of **free parking**.

An outstanding variety of local **food and drink** has become a hallmark. World famous Otto's grilled sausages and frosty lemonade are for sale by the grandchildren of Festival hosts, the Hostetters. The pub features Full Sail beers and Maryhill Winery will pour free wine for tasting and to sell by the glass or bottle. Fresh salads, sandwiches and ice cream are also available.
